Our two NDT Scholarship Holders

"I am so grateful to the Nicholas Danby Trust for supporting my continuing studies at the Conservatorium van Amsterdam. After completing the 'Pre-Master' course last year, I am now starting the Master's programme under the expert tuition of Pieter van Dijk. On arriving in Amsterdam, Pieter immediately challenged me to overhaul and refine my technique to better serve the wonderful historic instruments that we have at our disposal. We are enormously privileged to play the Müller organs in the Waalse Kerk Amsterdam (1734), the Bavo in Haarlem (1738), the Van Hagerbeer/Schnitger (1645/1725) in Alkmaar and the Adema organ in the Mozes en Aäronkerk (1841) on a weekly basis - a truly inspiring list of teaching instruments! Studying with Pieter on these organs has revealed a range of expression which I had previously thought impossible, and with a significantly developed stylistic awareness, my playing is already transformed. I am really excited to see how I can continue to progress over the next two years."
